

SUBJECT: RENUNCIATION POLICY

Effective 11/01/99 Administrative Directive 05.08.105, RENUNCIATION OF AFFILIATION WITH SECURITY THREAT GROUPS, was made applicable to all inmates in the custody of the Illinois Department of Corrections.

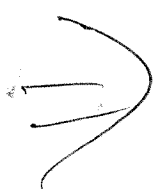
Administrative Directive 05.08.105 provides inmates an opportunity to renounce affiliation with a Security Threat Group at any time, however, requests will not be considered more than once every 180 days. Additionally, A.D. 05.08.105 stipulates that in order to become eligible for release from closed maximum security status, a validated Security Threat Group affiliate must renounce their affiliation. If a validated affiliate refuses to renounce affiliation with a Security Threat Group, that inmate shall be deemed ineligible for release from closed maximum security status, except in accordance with Department procedures as they relate to MSR/Parole.

When an inmate decides to renounce their affiliation with a Security Threat Group, a request to renounce must be submitted in writing to the Counselor. Subsequently, the inmate will be interviewed regarding their request to renounce Security Threat Group affiliation. In order for an inmate to renounce affiliation, that inmate must convince the Department that the inmate will no longer be a participatory member of a Security Threat Group.

After the interview has been conducted, a decision will be made on whether to accept or reject the inmate's request to renounce. When that decision has been made, the inmate shall be advised of whether their request was accepted or **rejected**. If the renouncement is rejected, the inmate may grieve the decision in accordance with D.R. 504 F.
